

## Most Simple Comment Spam protection for 1.4.x

### Comment spam protection using Single image as visual confirmation.

#### Features:

- This is a *CAPTCHA Alternative* which is independent of your hosting server setting.
- It is very simple and only 3 lines are added to the db\_input.php file.
- Other functions of coppermine gallery are not affected.
- No server side font Support is required.
- You can create your own image with code written on it.
- No server side dynamic image generation support is required.
- If you want to disable this Hack, simply remove those 3 Lines added to db\_input2.php.
- It takes hardly 5-10 minutes to make this work properly.
- It easy to add and easy to remove and works 100% on any server.
- Special Thanks to all people who gave the feedback on the mod thread.

#### Brief Details:

Files needed (attached in this zipped folder)

- 1-- **done.php** ( to indicate error to the visitor and redirecting it to another page.)
- 2-- **capimage.jpg** ( in the following example the image is located at <http://www.yoursite.com/CPG/Themes/classic/images/capimage.jpg> ( URL of this image can be changed in step 2)
- 3-- **db\_input2.php** (File which will be used for comment addition.)
- 4— **db\_input.php** (3 lines code is added to this to prevent bots accessing it to add spam comments directly)

#### Steps:

**STEP 1** - Open theme.php file which you are using and check if this code exist in it or not. IF CODE EXISTS SKIP TO step 2.

**STEP 2: IF CODE Exists** then Select all of that CODE under "HTML template for the form to add comments" and replace it with the following code.  
**(IF CODE DOES NOT EXIST** In your theme.php then copy and paste the CODE given below into your theme.php just before last line of file (above the "<?>" tag). )

**STEP 3:** Now download the file done.php attached with this post and upload it to the root of your coppermine gallery (same place where db\_input.php and db\_input2.php are located)

**STEP 4:** Download the file capimage.jpg attached with this post and upload it to wherever u want to put it. **Don't forget** to change the URL of that image properly in Step 2 then.

**STEP 5:** Open db\_input2.php file and find these Line in it in the beginning of the file

**STEP 6:** Add this just below these lines So it becomes

die();
}

**Step 7:** Save the db\_input2.php file.

**Step 8:** From the zipped folder upload db\_input.php to your server and overwrite the previous db\_input.php file.

And that is it. Your Simple personal spam protection is working now.
